Venturing Crew #77 and Minsi Trails Council are pleased to offer the American Red Cross Adult CPR/AED course.

Course Description:

This is a nationally certified American Red Cross course. Participants successfully completing the course will receive a certificate for CPR/AED-Adult which is valid for one year.

This course teaches how to do cardiopulmonary resuscitation, how to use an automated external defibrillator (AED), recognize and care for victims of heart attacks and choking.

This course is designed to meet OSHA guidelines for the workplace.

Topics covered:

Rescue breathing, choking, adult one-rescuer CPR, use of an automated external defibrillator (AED), emergency action steps, scene assessment and management, patient assessment and records, disease transmission prevention, and contacting help.

Prerequisites:

There are no prerequisites required.

Participants:

Participation is open to all Venturers and Boy Scouts aged 14+ and leaders. All Venturers and Scouts must have the approval of their Crew Advisor or Scoutmaster.

Costs:

The cost for the course includes educational materials, supplies, and certificates. Please contact Chris Lubenetski for cost.

Course Length:

The length of the course is approximately 4 hours.
