Course Description:

This is a nationally certified American Red Cross course. Participants successfully completing the course will receive a certificate for Standard First Aid which is valid for three years.

This course teaches how to recognize and care for victims of injury or sudden illness plus how to treat cuts, bruises, bone and muscle injuries, shock, bleeding and other first aid emergencies.

Topics covered:

Emergency action steps, scene assessment and management, patient assessment and records, disease transmission prevention, contacting help, wounds, injuries, sudden illnesses, and bee stings.

Prerequisites:

There are no prerequisites required.

Participants:

Participation is open to all Venturers and Boy Scouts aged 14+ and leaders. All Venturers and Scouts must have the approval of their Crew Advisor or Scoutmaster.

Costs:

The cost for the course includes educational materials, supplies, and certificates. Please contact Chris Lubenetski for the cost of the course.

Course Length:

The length of the course is approximately 4 hours. This does not include CPR/AED training. If you would like CPR/AED training please contact Crew #77.
