



American Red Cross Wilderness & Remote First Aid Course

INFORMATION SHEET (As of July 2010)

Venturing Crew #77 and Minsi Trails Council are pleased to offer the American Red Cross Wilderness & Remote First Aid Course.

Course Description:

This is a nationally certified American Red Cross course. Participants successfully completing the course will receive a certificate for Wilderness & Remote First Aid which is valid for two years.

Completion of this course is now required for all crews going to Philmont Scout Reservation in New Mexico. At least one person per crew must be certified (it is strongly recommended that at least two people are certified).

This course is recommended in the Guide to Safe Scouting for all groups conducting wilderness camping. Trek Safely guidelines specifically mention it.

Completion of this course satisfies the core First Aid requirements for Outdoor Bronze or the Ranger Award (Note: This course **does not** meet the elective requirements).

Topics covered:

Delayed-help situations, emergency action steps, scene assessment and management, patient assessment and records, disease transmission prevention, prioritizing care, contacting help, long term care, wounds, injuries, sudden illnesses, bites & stings, backcountry miseries, plan execution, and evacuation planning.

Prerequisites:

Current CPR certification **IS** required (arrangements can be made to obtain certification prior to course). There are no first aid prerequisites required, but basic first aid skills are recommended (example: Boy Scout First Aid M.B. skills).

Participants:

Participation is open to all Venturers and Boy Scouts aged 14+ and leaders. All Venturers and Scouts must have the approval of their Crew Advisor or Scoutmaster.

Costs:

The cost for the course includes educational materials, supplies, certificates, and food. Costs vary depending on course size, location, and costs for supplies and lodging. Please contact Chris Lubenetski to schedule a course and for costs.

Course Length:

The length of the course is approximately 20 hours. This does not include CPR/AED training. If you would like CPR/AED training please contact Venturing Crew #77.
