Fall Victim with Puncture Wound Scenario

Scenario: Your patrol is hiking near Tenderfoot Pass when the patrol hears a scream and sees a male lying at the bottom of the canyon. While the patrol is approaching the victim, you observe that it is an approximate 25 year old male that is conscious. The victim then removes a branch (approximately ½" in diameter) that impaled him in the left thigh (upper leg) and then goes unconscious. The male tumbled down the canyon approximately 50 feet. Upon reaching the victim, you notice the puncture wound is not bleeding heavily, but is oozing blood. It is unknown if he sustained any other injuries during the fall.

ACTION TAKEN	POSSIBLE POINTS	POINTS EARNED
APPROACHING THE SCENE	10 Max pts	
1. Scouts ask if the scene is safe.	5	
2. Scouts say they have medical gloves on or do have them on.	5	
GOING FOR HELP	5 Max pts	
1. Patrol sends two Scouts to call for help <i><u>(if only 1 scout goes, then 2 points)</u></i>	5	
CALLING FOR HELP	25 Max pts	
1. The Scout tells what happened		
a. 25 year old male involved in a fall	5	
b. Male is unconscious	5	
c. Male has a puncture wound from an impaled branch on the left thigh (upper leg)	5	
2. The Scout explains what is being done to the victim	5	
3. The scout gives the location as Tenderfoot Pass & states he will meet rescuers and guide them to the scene. <i><u>(if only 1 is done, then 2 points)</u></i>	5	
STABILIZE VICTIM	20 Max pts	
1. Patrol stabilizes the head by holding the head in the position found and not allowing the patient to move it.	20	
PUNCTURE WOUND TREATMENT PROCEDURE	20 Max pts	
1. Flush the wound with water	10	
2. Apply a sterile bandage.	10	

TREATMENT FOR SHOCK	5 Max pts	
1. Keep the victim warm by covering with a blanket.	5	
OTHER	5 Max pts	
1. Patrol does not move patient at all, including legs, etc.	5
