Burn and Laceration Scenario

Scenario: While making dinner at Camp Star's First Class Campsite, a 13 year old Scout cutting onions slips with the knife and cuts his left index finger. The scout, turns quickly hits a pot with boiling water and it spills onto his right forearm.

The Scout's right forearm is red and is beginning to blister. The Scout's left index finger is a minor laceration and he feels sick and faint.

Though the patrol has a cell phone available, there is no reception. The closest help is at the camp's health lodge, approximately 7 minutes away.

Only the patrol leader and the Scouts that go for help may speak to the judge.

SAFETY	10 Max pts	XXXXXX
1. Scouts say they have medical gloves on or do have them on.	10	
GOING FOR HELP	5 Max pts	XXXXXX
1. Patrol sends two Scouts to the Camp's Health Lodge <u>(if only 1 scout goes, then 2 points)</u> NOTE: Only 1 scout must go, but must say he is going with a buddy.	5	
CALLING FOR HELP	35 Max pts	XXXXXX
1. The Scout tells what happened	XXXXXXX	XXXXXX
a. 13 year old male	5	
b. Male burned his right forearm	5	
c. Male cut his left index finger	5	
d. Male feels sick and faint	5	
2. The Scout explains what is being done to the victim	5

LACERATION TREATMENT PROCEDURE	30 Max pts	XXXXXX
1. Clean with water, flushing for 5 minutes or until any foreign matter is removed.	10	
2. Apply triple antibiotic ointment (Neosporin) if no allergies or sensitivities to the medication.	10	
3. Covered with a dry, sterile dressing and bandage	10	
4. Covered with an adhesive bandage (band-aid) 3	10	
NOTE: POINTS ONLY GIVEN FOR EITHER #3 or #4, NOT BOTH	XXXXXXXX	XXXXXX
BURN TREATMENT	30 Max pts	XXXXXX
1. The patient's burn is cooled with cold, running water until the pain is relieved.	15	
2. When the burn area is dry, apply loosely a sterile gauze pad and bandage.	15	
3. <i>If butter, creams, ointments, or sprays are applied subtract 5 points</i>		
TREATMENT FOR SHOCK	10 Max pts	XXXXXX
1. Had the patient sit with his head between his knees or had him lay down and raised his legs about 12 inches.	10
