## **Automobile Accident Scenario**

Scenario: Your patrol is selling popcorn in the neighborhood, when you hear tires screech and a crash. Upon investigating, your patrol finds a car struck a parked car at the intersection of Brackett Drive and Morton Lane. A passer-by states that he pulled the driver out of the car and points to where he is. The driver of the vehicle is laying about 10 feet from the car in the grass. The driver tells you that he is 42 years old and swerved to miss a dog and struck the parked car at about 30 MPH. The driver is complaining of right leg pain and head pain. Your patrol observes a deformed lower right leg (indicating a break) and a 2" laceration above the left eye that is bleeding. There are obvious signs that the driver struck his head on the windshield (you suspect a possible head/neck injury). There is no glass in the wound. The by-stander leaves and does not tell anyone where he is going.

Fire Station #51 is a block from the accident scene and the station is staffed 24 hours a day.

Only the patrol leader and the Scout(s) getting help may speak to the judge.
