Seizure & Nosebleed Scenario

Scenario: Your patrol is participating in the Due North Map and Compass Competition. The weather is approximately 60° with a cool breeze. The competition began at Tenderfoot Lodge and continues through the town of Mayberry. The competition headquarters is located at Tenderfoot Lodge.

After leaving Tenderfoot Lodge and walking approximately two blocks, your patrol observes an approximate 22 year old male having an active seizure on the sidewalk ahead. No one else is nearby the victim. The seizure is still active when you get there and only lasts about 1 minute after you arrive.

While helping the seizure patient, one of the scouts in the patrol develops a nosebleed. The scout gets frequent nosebleeds and it is not trauma related.

SEIZURE TREATMENT PROCEDURE	50 Max pts	
 Cleared space around the victim. 	10	
Protected the patient's head (used padding)	10	
3. Loosened any tight clothing	5	
(if no clothing to be loosened, ask if you would, if yes give 5 points)		
4. Reassured patient when he recovers from seizure.	5	
5. Placed victim in recovery position.	5	
6. Monitored patient-made sure airway remained open.	5	
7. Did NOT put anything in the victim's mouth during seizure.	5	
8. Did NOT try to hold victim down or stop the seizure.	5	

NOSEBLEED TREATMENT PROCEDURE	30 Max pts	
Had scout sit down and lean head forward	10	
2. Had scout pinch soft part of nose for 10 minutes	10	
(can be done by victim or another scout)		
3. Did NOT encourage scout to blow nose.	5	
 Placed cold compress against the nose and surrounding area. 	5
