## **Burn & Laceration Scenario**

Scenario: While making dinner at Camp Star's First Class Campsite, a scout spills boiling water on his left forearm and screams. A nearby scout cutting onions looks up and cuts his left index finger with a knife.

The first scout's left forearm is red and is beginning to blister. The second scout's left index finger is a minor laceration and he feels sick and faint.

Though the patrol has a cell phone available, there is no reception. The closest help is at the camp's health lodge, approximately 7 minutes away.

Only the patrol leader and the Scouts that go for help may speak to the judge.

1. Clean with water, flushing for 5 minutes or until any	5
foreign matter is removed.	
Apply triple antibiotic ointment (Neosporin) if no	10
